

At the close of yesterday, September 29, a total of 77 patients are admitted, 43 suspected and 34 confirmed active.

For COVID-19, a total of 1,086 samples were taken for surveillance, with 7 being positive. The country has accumulated 14,150,243 samples and 1,111,186 positives.

The total number of cases (7): 4 were contacts of confirmed cases, 0 with a source of infection abroad and 3 without a specified source of infection. Of the 7 cases diagnosed, 4 were female and 3 male.

0 asymptomatic cases are reported on the day, accumulating a total of 147,503, which represents (13.3%) of those confirmed to date.

The 7 diagnosed cases belong to the age groups: under 20 years old, (4), from 20 to 39 years old, (1), from 40 to 59 years old (2) and over 60, (0).

Of the 111,186 million patients diagnosed with the disease, 34 remain hospitalized, 33 of them with stable clinical evolution (97.1%). There are 8,530 deaths (0 on the day), a lethality of 0.77% vs 1.05% in the world and 1.59% in the Americas; two evacuees, 57 returned to their countries, on the day there were 15 discharges, they accumulate 1 million 102 thousand 563 (99.2%). 1 confirmed serious patient is treated in Intensive Care.
