Mon. Access occurred in the municipality of Bahía Honda, at 22 ° 49 '35 "North Latitude and 83 ° 15' 25" West Longitude, Artemisa province. National Monument. Type: Historic site. This battle was an Antonio Maceo's portentous feat. It constitutes one of the most glorious deeds in Cuba's military history in its struggles for national liberation. It surpassed the national sphere, creating a situation of unease in the colonial administration. It seriously questioned the Weylerian assertion that Cacarajícara was a Hispanic triumph, when in reality, the most immediate purpose was not achieved, which was to evict Antonio Maceo from the region. The Cuban triumph in this battle demonstrated the combative capacity and the consecration of those who, moved by the sublime ideal of independence, were able to erase any difference.
